**NSDAA Board Minutes**

We had our working meeting before our regular board on Saturday evening, **October 28, 2006** at the Archives' Room located on the former Nebraska School for the Deaf campus in Omaha, Nebraska. President Darnall called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

**Present:** President Linsay Darnall, Jr., Vice-President Julie Dahlke, Treasurer Robert Chadwick, Secretary Peggy Scherling, Historian Daniel Darnall, and Tricia Tighe.

Minutes of July 28, 2006 were read and approved with two corrections.

**President's Report:** President Darnall announced that he received an invitation to Kiwanis's Club on November 1st to give a brief speech about NSD museum and our Master Plan.
